



## **Connecting to Eduroam on a Chromebook**

Eduroam requires a certificate to be present on your laptop. You will need to download this then manually add it to your Chromebook.

> • Firstly temporarily connect to "wolfradiolan" A message may display stating limited connectivity, this is normal

Download your eduroam installer	:
Chrome OS	l
After downloading the file, open the Chrome browser and browse to this URL: chrome://net-internals/#chromeos. Then, use the 'Import ONC file' button. The Import is silent; the new network definitions will be added to the preference networks.	
When the installer asks for Username and Password, use your University email address and logon password Continue

- Load your web browser and navigate to: cat.eduroam.org and select the University of Wolverhampton from the top right
- Follow the prompts to download the ONC file and remember where you save this
- In Chrome navigate to: chrome://net-internals/#chromeos
- Select "Choose File" and pick the ONC file you previously downloaded Please note there will be no confirmation
- Now disconnect from wolfradiolan and select eduroam
- The Server CA certificate will start "UoW..."
- Under Identity enter your student number followed by @unv.wlv.ac.uk for example: 1234567@unv.wlv.ac.uk
- Enter your IT Account password. This is the password you use to logon to a University PC
- Connect Click connect
